Afternoon block - 12:30pm – 4:30pm/5:30pm (4-5hrs assist with pack down) **Meeting time/point:** 12:30pm at the STAV Table Ground floor, Sidney Myer Asia Centre, UoM, Parkville.

Volunteer Roles: general assistance includes (but not limited to):

- assisting delegates with directions for sessions with reference to [MazeMap](#) app.
- assist with promoting Community Expo – reminding delegates to look out for any competitions on the day, referring delegates to utilise their Attendee Hub App from their mobile phone/other device.

Volunteer Benefits: Registration is complimentary. Volunteers may attend plenary and other sessions as well as opportunities to network with teachers during the breaks. A Certificate of Participation for Professional Development is provided post-conference.
