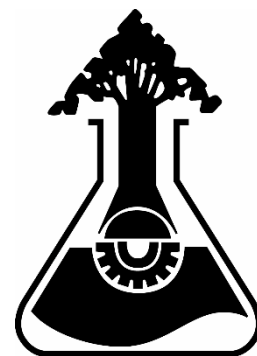


STS Oral Presentations

Helpful tips and file sharing options for submitting your video



Example: Google drive

Before you send the link, ensure it is set so that anyone who has the link can access

Link sharing

On – Public on the web
Anyone on the Internet can find and access this. No sign-in required.

On – Anyone with the link
Anyone who has the link can access. No sign-in required.

Off – Specific people
Shared with specific people.
