



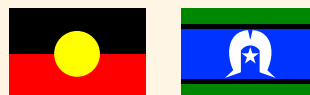

Authenticity and innovation:

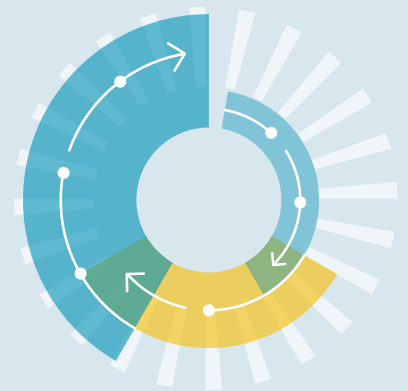
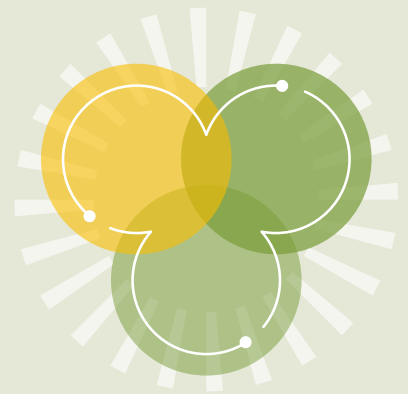
We listen carefully and reflect on practice and value critical thinking. We model scientific process and seek to constantly learn and improve.
